2. Authorize the Department of Recreation and Park's (RAP) General Manager, Chief Accounting Employee, or designee to make technical corrections as necessary, consistent with the intent of this Report.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

RAP anticipates additional appropriations needed in the Salaries As-Needed account in the amount of \$980,000, the Uniforms account in the amount of \$500,000, and the Operating Supplies account in the amount of \$1,200,000.

Costs for as-needed employees are expected to rise due to an anticipated 3% Cost-Of-Living-

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Adjustment to wages which is expected to take effect in April 2024. In addition, Gang Reduction and Youth Development (GRYD) as-needed staff received wage increases which raised their bonuses from fifty cents per hour to one dollar per hour.

Per the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) agreements, RAP is required to provide uniforms and uniform allowances to full-time and part-time Aquatics staff members. Costs for uniforms and other necessary departmental operating supplies have risen due to economic inflation.

These transfers of funds are needed due to upcoming seasonal programming which includes summer recreational and aquatic programming (e.g. preparation for RAP's summer 2024 pool operation), summer camps, and other special assignments and unforeseen events (e.g. extreme weather and fire watch). These appropriations are also needed to meet requirements, deadlines, and RAP's other operational needs for this fiscal year.

FISCAL IMPACT

The transfers between accounts within Fund 302 are for a budgetary adjustment that has a net zero impact on RAP's General Fund.
