

Registration / League Information

Below you will find some extra information about the league format and some clarification regarding registration procedures, etc. We hope that this extra information will help us all have a smooth and easy registration period, and a great season to come.

Priority Registration:

Priority Registration will only be extended to those teams from the most recent season (summer-fall 2011)

Priority Registration begins at 8:00 am on Monday, February 6, 2012, and goes until Thursday, February 9, 2012, at 4:00pm (unless slots are filled prior to this date/time). Open Registration begins at 8:00am on Monday, February 13, 2012, and continues until all divisions are full.

Please note: "priority" is not a guarantee of a space!!! Priority simply means that you are eligible to register (if space is available) prior to opening-up league registration to outside (or "new") teams. No team is guaranteed a spot. If you are serious about getting into the league, we suggest that you make arrangements to visit our office on Monday, February 6th, as early as possible. During registration for the past few seasons, some divisions have filled-up before 12 noon on the first day of Priority Registration. **Any** designee can register your team...it does not have to be a Manager or Coach. As long as the Manager has signed the registration form, and the designee is able to make full payment (including any/all outstanding teams fines, red cards, etc. by check, money order or credit/debit card), someone else can register for you, if you are unable to do it yourself.

Moving Divisions:

Some teams will be **required** to move up or down a division. The list of such teams will be attached to the same e-mail as this document. Please adhere to this list, as the person processing your registration will not override it.

Full Divisions:

If your division is full, you will be placed on the waiting list. You will **not** be able to elect to move up or down a division. This will hopefully keep the divisions balanced in playing strength. Your only other option, if your division is full, would be to sign-up for Friday Open or 7 v 7 (if space is available at the time of registration).

League / Division Structure:

Please see below for a description of the league structure.

Sunday Divisions: All Sunday divisions will once again offer an A.M. and a P.M. session. We will accept six (6) teams in each A.M. and P.M.), with each sub-division playing two rounds (10 games total). The sub-division (i.e. Minor A.M.) winner will be the team with the most points at the end of regular play. The winning teams (only) will receive a team awards, as well as individual awards. There will be a play-off for Division Champion. Two (2) teams from each sub-division will advance to the play-offs (top 2 teams from A.M. and top 2 from P.M.). The semi-final round of the play-offs will consist of the two A.M. winners playing against the two P.M. winners. The final round will be between the two remaining winners and will decide the Division Champion (and second place in the division). First and second place will receive a team award.

Weekday Divisions: 12 teams will be accepted for each of the following divisions: 30+ Tuesday, 40+ Wednesday, 30+ Thursday, and Friday Open. Each division will be divided into two subdivisions (A and B), with each sub-division playing two rounds (10 games total). The winners, awards and play-offs will follow the same format as the Sunday Divisions (see above).

7 v 7 League: 7 v 7 will continue to play on Monday nights. **NOTE:** The 7v7 Friday nights have been moved to Saturday nights. Six (6) teams will be accepted in the Women's Division and six (6) teams in the Men's Division. Each division will play two rounds, for a total of 10 games. The winner of each division will be the team with the most points at the end of the season. Both first and second place teams will receive a team award as well as individual awards. No playoffs for this divisions.

Women's League: The Women's League will continue to play on Saturdays. We will be offering an (A) and (B) sub divisions. We will accept six (6) teams in each A and B, with each sub division playing two rounds (10 games total). The winner of each sub division will be the team with the most points at the end of regular season play. The winning team (only) will receive a team award as well as individual award. There will be play-off for Division Champion. Two teams from each sub division will advance to the play-offs. The semi-final round of the play-offs will consist of the two (A) winners playing against the two (B) winners. The final round will be between the two remaining winners and will decide the Division Champion (and second place in the Division). First and second place will receive a team award.

Cal South / I.D. Cards:

Any and all I.D. cards will continue to be obtained directly from Cal South. Please contact Cal South directly for any and all I.D. related issues. New players will need to register on-line with Cal South and pay the registration fee prior to obtaining an I.D. card. Continuing players will not need to register again with Cal South this season (current Cal South registration is valid until July, 2012).
