RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board approve the following amendment to the existing Golf Tournament Policy allowing the Public Links Golf Association of Southern California to hold two weekday shotgun tournaments annually on Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday at one of the Department's 36-hole golf complexes only.

SUMMARY:

The Golf Advisory Committee recently recommended the approval of the following change to the Department's Golf Tournament Policy.

SECTION II 4.A

Public Links Golf Association of Southern California (P.L.G.A.S.C.) is permitted to hold four (4) weekend tournaments throughout the year. Each tournament is limited to 60 players. The P.L.G.A.S.C. may increase the number of players by adjusting the number of tournaments held each year in coordination with the reservation supervisor and/or course manager. Players will be charged regular weekend rates. Green fees will be paid with one check on the day of play, a minimum of 15 minutes prior to the first tee-off time. P.L.G.A.S.C. is responsible for payment of all tee times left un used during their reserved play (Rates & Fees, 1995). P.L.G.A.S.C. may hold two weekday shotgun tournaments annually on Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday at one of the Department's 36-hole golf complexes only. The tee time will be 7:30 a.m. The fee will be the regular daily rate and must include the \$5.00 payment to the food and pro shop concessionaires. Electric carts are required. Payment for the shotgun tournament will be made 15 days in advance of the scheduled tournament for the required minimum of 128 players. Additional players may be added the day of play to a maximum of 160 players if paid for prior to tee time. There will be no refunds for having fewer than the required minimum 128 players.
