

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board approve the use of the Lifeline rates for qualified men's and women's club golfers playing in MGA Affiliate Golf Club tournaments or play days held on non-holiday weekdays only.

SUMMARY:

Staff recently completed a review of the existing tournament policy with the Golf Advisory Committee. The Golf Advisory Committee voted unanimously in recommending that the Board approve the following change to the Department's Golf Tournament Policy.

Affiliate Groups Section IV, Page 1

3. The Men's and Women's Clubs at 18-hole courses only, pay \$2.00 less than the established weekday and weekend green fees. The Men's and Women's Clubs at 9-hole courses, pay \$1.00 less than the established weekday and weekend green fees. Senior Rates ~~Lifetime Rates~~, and Junior rates do not apply; *Lifeline rates apply for weekday non-holiday club tournaments or play days.* Women's clubs may pay individually a minimum of 15 minutes prior to their tee times. Women's clubs must pay the full M.G.A. rate for any tee times left unused and unfilled during their reserved play before the end of the business day. Men's clubs will pay with one check a minimum of 15 minutes prior to their first tee time on the day of play for all times reserved.
