



RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board approve amending the current golf policy by allowing junior golfers weekend and holiday access to all Department courses at junior weekday rates, on a walk-on basis only, subject to no existing reservations and no call sheet.

SUMMARY:

Currently, junior golfers are allowed weekend or holiday access to Department courses at the full adult rate. Staff recently presented a proposal to the Golf Advisory Committee that would allow junior golfers weekend and holiday access to Department courses at junior weekday rates, on a walk-on basis only, subject to no existing reservations and no call sheet. The Golf Advisory Committee voted unanimously to accept this recommendation. Permitting weekend and holiday access at junior rates will encourage junior participation in golf by maintaining interest throughout the year.

The following changes to the Rates and Fees are recommended:

STUDENT/JUNIOR GREEN FEES (Junior rates apply until September 1 of one's year of high school graduation or one's 19th birthday, whichever comes first.)

Any golfer age 13 or younger must be certified in order to play.

Weekend/Holiday access: Junior golfers will be charged the regular weekday junior rate on weekends and holidays, on a walk-on basis only, subject to no existing reservations and no call sheet.
