

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board extend the Memorandum of Understanding between the Department and the Community Development Department/L.A. Bridges for cooperative assistance in the development, implementation, and evaluation of a CLASS Parks Youth Intervention Program for CLASS staff, youth served, and their families until June 30, 2002.

SUMMARY:

At the June 6, 2001 Commissioners' Meeting, item number 01-206 authorizing a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department and the Community Development Department/L.A. Bridges for development of a CLASS Parks Intervention Component was approved. The MOU was to be in effect from July 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001.

Due to delays in securing appropriate signatures from both Departments, the City Attorney, and the Mayor's Office, this program has not yet been implemented. All signatures have now been obtained and both Departments have agreed to conduct the program from January 1, 2002 to June 30, 2002.

There will be no fiscal impact associated with this change.
