

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board approve the request for fee reduction by Western States Golf Association from the tournament rate to the normal daily rate for the Southern Area Youth Program Golf Tournament to be held on Friday, September 27, 2002, at Rancho Park Golf Course. The net proceeds from this golf event will be used to support the WSGA's Southern Area Scholarship Program. The tournament is scheduled for 80 players.

SUMMARY:

Western States Golf Association (WSGA) is an established 501(c)3 non-profit youth golf association, which has introduced and trained thousands of inner city youth to the sport of golf since 1982. In addition to their own successful scholarship program, many of the youth who participated in their program have financed their college educations through golf scholarships. The WSGA also oversees the operation of the training academy at the Department's Maggie Hathaway Golf Course.

The WSGA has requested a reduction in green fee from the tournament rate of \$27.00 per round to the normal daily rate of \$21.00 per round. Granting this request would be revenue neutral and would build goodwill with a well-known non-profit youth organization, as well as benefit inner city youth. The Golf Advisory Committee has been made aware of this request.
