

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board amend Personnel Resolution No. 9932 effective immediately as follows:

2. Release the above positions from substitute authority for the remainder of the fiscal year.

SUMMARY:

Mac Arthur Park and its adjacent lake is being rebuilt as a full service recreation center that will include an array of programming to service all age groups within the community. The park boasts a separate facility housing the Senior Citizen Center.

Rose Hill Recreation Center is adjacent to Debs Park, a former county regional park, recently acquired by the Department as part of the five-year Proposition K plan. The combined facility is 300 acres. The Department will provide additional programming, sanction community permit picnic reservations, and serve a liaison role with the existing Debs Park Advisory Board.

Due to the size of these facilities, the level of responsibility, and the numerous programs to be offered, the Department believes that the duties would be more appropriately allocated to a Senior Recreation Director. The Department intends to request these positions be exempted from the current hiring freeze prior to filling the vacancies.

It is estimated that the additional cost to fund these positions for the remainder of the fiscal year is \$4,611.00. Positions number 461 and 492 will remain vacant to fund the upgrade.
