RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board accept the donation of two decommissioned lifeguard towers authorized by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors for use at Cabrillo Beach for the benefit and safety of the public, and that the proper recognition be given to the donor.

SUMMARY:

On December 17, 2002, on motion of Supervisor Don Knabe, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors authorized the Director of Beaches and Harbors in coordination with the Director of Internal Services to donate two decommissioned lifeguard towers to the Department for use at Cabrillo Beach to replace existing equipment that is old, dilapidated, and contains lead paint. The lifeguard towers being donated, valued at approximately \$10,000 each, are near-new condition and will provide improved observation platforms for better supervision of the swimming and beach areas. Department construction crews will responsible for relocating the towers from their present location at Dockweiler Beach and installing at Cabrillo Beach.
