

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board:

1. Approve final plans and specifications for Griffith Park Recreation Center – Outdoor Sportsfield Improvements and Perimeter Fencing W.O. #E170256F; and
2. Approve the date for receipt of bids as Tuesday, May 18, 2004, at 3:00 PM, in the Board Room.

SUMMARY:

Submitted are final plans and specifications for the Griffith Park Recreation Center improvements, located at 3401 Riverside Drive. The project is a Prop K specified project. Plans for this project were prepared by a consultant to the Department of Recreation & Parks, Land Images. Their estimate for the construction cost of this project is \$780,000. The plans provide for removal and replacement of an existing soccer field with a synthetic turf soccer field, including:

1. Removal and replacement of an existing soccer field with a synthetic turf soccer field.
2. Soccer field low perimeter chain link fence.
3. Irrigation system modifications.
4. 6" concrete bleacher pad.
5. Relocation of existing bleachers.
6. Concrete walkway/decomposed granite path.
7. Perimeter sod and landscaping.

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The project will be funded for construction through Prop K and a State of California Land and Water Conservation Grant (LWCF).

The LWCF grant is a reimbursable grant.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), staff has determined that the proposed improvements will not have a significant impact on the environment. This project has been determined to be Categorical Exempt per City CEQA guidelines Article VII, Section 1a (existing facilities). A Notice of Exemption was filed with the Los Angeles City Clerk's office on April 23, 2002, and posted by the County Clerk's office on April 23, 2002.

The bid package has been approved by the City Attorney's Office.
