SUBJECT: ALISO CANYON PARK - STATUS OF TEMPORARY RIGHT OF ENTRY PERMIT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER

On August 11, 2004, the Board, through Board Report No. 04-235, authorized the Department to issue a temporary right-of-entry permit to Springville Properties, LLC, and/or its contractors to enter onto portions of Aliso Canyon Park for the purpose of planning and constructing a public sanitary sewer. Subsequent to the Department's issuance of this authorized permit, it was determined that the permittee had violated certain terms and conditions of the temporary permit. Department staff was in the process of instructing the permittee to suspend all operations on park property, when the matter was brought forward to the Board's attention at the last Board meeting by several members of the community. On October 20, 2004, Department staff instructed the permittee to suspend all operations on park property.

On October 27, 2004, Department staff met with representatives of the permittee and the Department of Public Works to discuss the permit violations. The permittee has acknowledged its responsibility for the violations and has agreed to remedy the situation to the satisfaction of Department staff. On October 29, 2004, the permittee was informed that it could resume operations on park property subject to the conditions discussed and agreed upon at the October 27 meeting. The permittee was put on notice that should there be any further violations the Department will rescind the permit and no further work will be allowed on park property.



SUBJECT: SUMMER EXTENDED POOL SEASON 2004



The 2004 summer pool season operation was extended beyond the September 6, 2004 closing date to September 19, 2004 at five seasonal and 15 year round pools. This report summarizes the costs for extending the pool season and includes staffing costs per seasonal and year round pool, additional chemical expenses, and attendance figures. The costs will be absorbed by the Department of Recreation and Parks, Aquatic Division. The extended season's total attendance was 38,575.

Costs include *five seasonal* pools for 13 days.
