1. Approve final plans and specifications for State Street Recreation Center – Field Improvements (#1353A) (W.O. #E170957F); and,
2. Approve the date for receipt of bids as Tuesday, December 7, 2004, at 3:00 PM, in the Board Office.

SUMMARY:

Submitted are final plans and specifications for the State Street Recreation Center - Field Improvements, located at 716 North State Street. Plans for this project were prepared by the Recreation and Parks' Department of Planning and Construction Division, who have estimated the cost of construction of this project as \$116,400.00. The estimate has been reviewed and confirmed by Bureau of Engineering. The plans provide for field improvements as follows:

1. Upgrades to existing irrigation system.
2. Removal and replacement electrical service.
3. Renovation of baseball field.
4. Removal and replacement infield mix.

Funds for construction will be available for the proposed improvements in the following Proposition 12 fund:
