

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board:

1. Approve final plans and specifications for Ritchie Valens Recreation Center – Sportfield Lighting Project (W.O. #E170285F); and,
2. Approve the date for receipt of bids as Tuesday, December 7, 2004, at 3:00 PM, in the Board Office.

SUMMARY:

Submitted are final plans and specifications for the Ritchie Valens Recreation Center – Sportsfield Lighting improvements, located at 10732 North Laurel Canyon Boulevard. The project is a Prop K specified project. Plans for this project were prepared by the Bureau of Engineering, Mechanical and Electrical Group, who have estimated the cost of construction of this project at \$130,000. The plans provide for new sports field lighting for two existing Baseball Fields.

Funds for construction are available for the proposed improvements in the following Proposition K fund:
