RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board:

1. Approve final plans and specifications for Woodbridge Park – Outdoor Improvements (W.O. #E170264F); and,
2. Approve the date for receipt of bids as Tuesday, December 7, 2004, at 3:00 PM, in the Board Office.

SUMMARY:

Submitted are final plans and specifications for the Woodbridge Park – Outdoor Improvements project, located at 11240 Moorpark Street. The project is a Prop K specified project. Plans for this project were prepared by the Department of Recreation and Parks Design Consultant, Cornerstone Studio, Inc., who have estimated the cost of construction of this project as \$109,000.00. The plans provide for outdoor park improvements, as follows:

1. New landscaped park entrance and new facility sign.
2. New park benches.
3. New play ground equipment and resilient surfacing at existing play ground area.
4. Replacement of deteriorated wood fencing.
5. New shade structure.

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Funds for construction are available for the proposed improvements in the following Proposition K fund:

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), staff has determined that the proposed improvements will not have a significant impact on the environment. The bid package has been approved by the City Attorney's Office.
