Refund Policy:

A nonrefundable administration fee of 15% of the receipted amount will be assessed by the Child Care Center for any patron requesting a refund, change, or transfer per session/week. **No full refund will be issued unless class/session is canceled by the Center.**

Extended Morning Care:

There is an additional fee of \$80.00 per 4 week session for extended morning care per child. Availability of morning care depends on the number of registrants. Morning care hours are from 7:00 am to 8:30 am

Walk-in registration is acceptable Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:30 pm

*Enrollment is limited, so register early.

*Annual Registration Fee is \$35.00 per Child.
