Teen Clubs, located at each CLASS Parks site, provide a variety of activities, and a safe, inviting atmosphere in which members can meet new friends, get together with old friends, get tutoring assistance with homework, do arts and crafts projects, and more. Teens have dedicated study time, tutoring assistance and homework help. Hours are Monday through Friday from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm. Teens have access to computers for homework use.

Drop-In hours are Tuesday – Friday from 4:00 – 8:00 pm and Saturday from 1:00 – 5:00 pm. Teens can play sports, study, play games and Play Station 2, help with the Sports or After School programs, use the computers, or just hang out. *BE sure to Check out the Teen Club Brochure for upcoming events and activities.*

Teen Leadership is encouraged, where teens can advocate for themselves and their peers to plan and organize activities and events. Some monthly activities include sport events, theatrical plays, cultural / social activities, events and festivities. Teens learn public behavior, volunteer around the park, and do community service while learning about themselves, their community, broaden their cultural awareness and have fun.



Fred Roberts Recreation Center Teen Club, a CLASS Parks / Youth Plus Program site, can participate in the Adventure Program, which has three components: QUEST, APEX, and ECO/Expedition. QUEST has a wide variety of activities and locations, offering something for almost everyone and guarantees something new and different for participants. APEX and ECO/EX offers more exciting, more challenging activities, utilizing many of the skills acquired in QUEST, giving teens the opportunity to grow, learn life skills, team building, and achieve individual accomplishments far beyond their expectations in safe and controlled environments. Adventure Programs include, but are not limited to activities such as Ropes Course, Wall Climbing, Horseback riding, Camping, Skateboarding, Skiing, Snowboarding, Surfing, Snorkeling, Kayaking and more.



CLASS Parks also offers youth the Youth Employment Internship Program (Y.E.I.P.), which provides youth with fundamental life skills (i.e. money management, professional etiquette, resume writing, and job search activities), while facilitating the youth's transition into life after high school. Courses can include, but are not limited to: Camp Counselor Leadership, Sports Officiating, Film Production, CSI – Crime Scene Investigation, and “on-the job” training at the Anson Ford Theater. Training takes place on Saturdays and sites vary each quarter at different CLASS parks.
