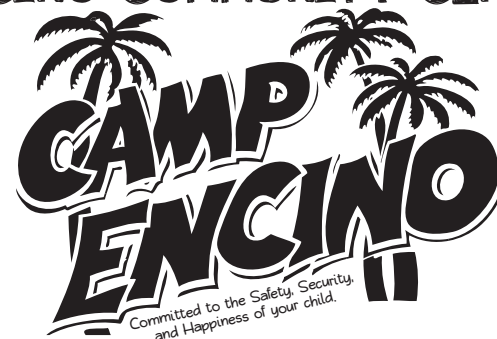

# REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Spring Camp registration begins Monday, February 13, 2012. Registration will continue until camp is filled. You must enroll in person at the Encino Community Center. Please have all pertinent medical information and emergency numbers with you.

We accept Visa and Mastercard. Please make checks payable to LA City Department of Recreation and Parks. All fees must be paid in full at time of registration.

Camper must be age appropriate by the first day of camp. Proof of age may be requested. Persons with disabilities are welcome to participate in our programs. Reasonable accommodations will be made with prior arrangements.

## REFUNDS & CREDITS:

Refunds/credits may be issued for long term illnesses only provided that we receive a signed note from a licensed physician within 3 days of illness. Allow 6 - 8 weeks for processing. There will be a 15% processing fee for each refund. There will be no make-up days or day transfers.

## CAMP SHIRTS:

As a courtesy, one camp shirt will be provided per camper for the Spring Camp session. Additional shirts are available for \$10 each. Campers must wear their camp shirt to camp every day. In the event that your child is not wearing his/her camp shirt, one will be provided and you will be charged appropriately. Camp shirts cannot be altered or cut in any way.
