REFUND POLICY

Full refunds are only issued when the Recreation Center cancels the activity. A 15% cancellation fee is assessed for all refunds. Changes or transfers per class, sports league or day camp registration may be assessed additional fees. After the first day of a session, the Recreation Center issues a partial refund to patrons withdrawing from the activity. Refunds will **NOT** be granted to any person making false statements on registration forms. Refunds are issued by mail only and will take approx. 8-12 weeks to process.

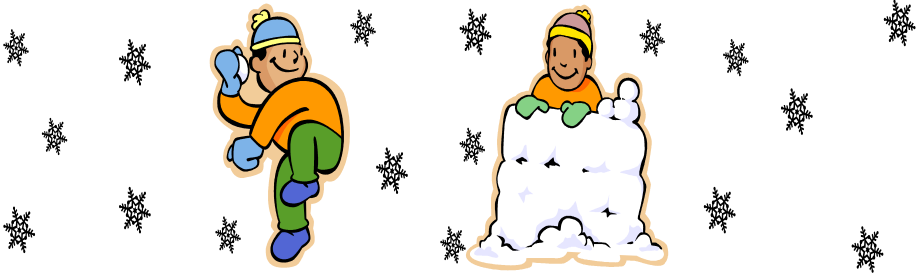

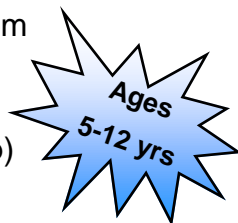
