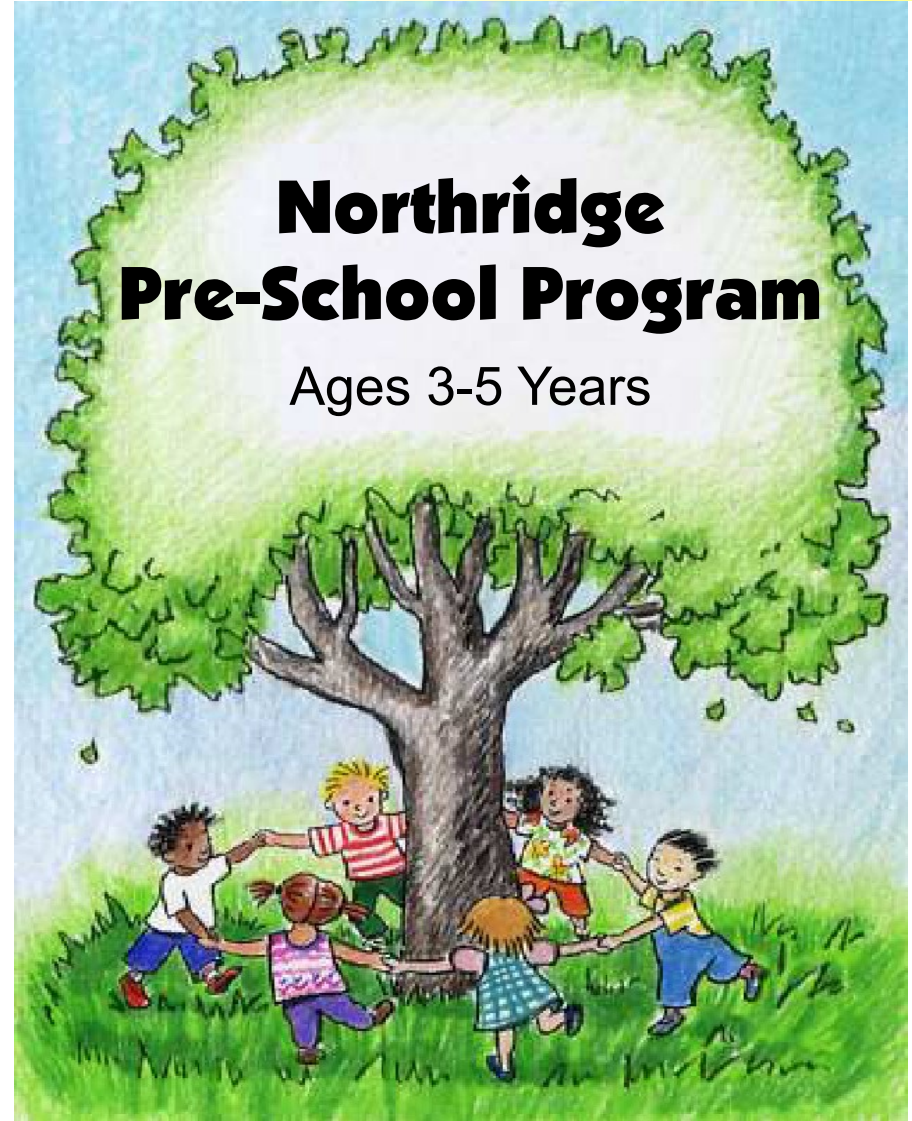

## **Registration Information**

Registration for Pre-School is on-going. Spaces are on a first come first served basis and are limited per day. Pre-Kinder is open year round with the exceptions of Summer, Winter, Spring, and Holiday breaks.

- √ Come in the office and pick up a Registration Application.
- √ Completely fill out the Application and return to the office.
- √ Bring a photo of your child, a copy of your child's Birth Certificate, Immunization Records, First Months Tuition and Registration Fees.

## **Fee's**

\$35.00 Annual non-refundable registration fee.

\$60.00 per week: 4 days (Monday - Thursday)

Tuition Payment is paid on a Monthly Basis by Check or Money Order Only.

## **Refund Policy**

A 15% administration fee will be accessed by the Recreation Center for any patron granted a refund. Registration fees are non-refundable. No full refunds will be issued unless the program is cancelled by the center. After the first day of a session, the Recreation Center issues a partial refund to patrons withdrawing from the activity.
