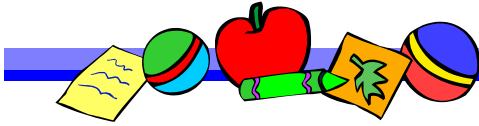

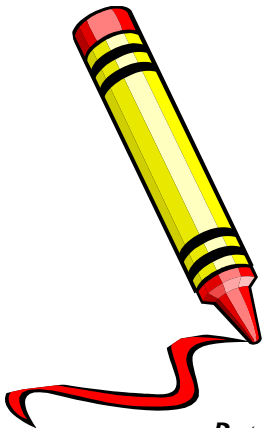
Enrollment Information
