PAYMENTS

Payment in full by check or money order must be made in person. Cash must be in exact amount. **Checks are to be made payable to "City of LA."** a \$35 collection fee will be charged for returned checks.

CLASS INFORMATION

Students must meet class age requirement by the beginning date of the session. Staff reserves the right to require proof of age at any time. Make-ups will not be scheduled when class is missed by a student. No refunds or credits will be given for classes missed. We ask that parents please wait outside the class area in order to avoid distraction among students participating in scheduled activities. By participating in our programs, patrons agree to allow the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks and the Tarzana Rec. Center to use photographs, video tapes, and testimonials of participants for use in publicity materials free of any fee or usage charge. Staff reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if minimum enrollment is not met. Class fees will **NOT** be prorated.

REFUND POLICY

There are no full refunds after the first week of program unless the program is cancelled by the facility. **All refunds are subject to a 15% processing fee.** There are no refunds once the program has begun, unless the class is changed or cancelled by the recreation center.
