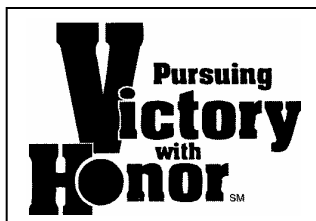

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## Rules/Guidelines for Open Play

The Municipal Sport Coordinator and/or the Facility Recreation Personnel have full authority to make any and all decisions pertinent to ensure safe, recreational play; and have the authority to eject any person/persons whose behavior in unsportsmanlike. There is zero tolerance for derogatory or abusive language or profanity. No alcohol, drugs or tobacco are allowed on or in Park facilities.

Play will be governed by Municipal Sport Rules, and refereed by the Coordinator. The coordinator has the right to remove any players who demonstrates unsafe play at any time.

Players are to check-in with Coordinator who will place players on teams. Teams of players are on a first come first serve bases. A maximum of six players will be placed on either side of the court for a full game, with appropriate rotation. The winning team will remain on the court and a new set of players will replace the losing team. Any team on the court for two consecutive games will leave the court regardless if they win or lose the 2<sup>nd</sup> game and a new set of players will play the next game. And so on while time permits.

Participants must wear appropriate clothing. Clothing should be loose enough to allow movement but not so baggy as to entangle or trip. Shorts or sweats are recommended; tennis/basketball type shoes must be worn at all times.
