Accept a donation (Donation) in the amount of TwentyTwo Thousand, Nine Hundred SeventyTwo Dollars and zero cents (\$22,972.00) from Burgis Holdings, LLC in support of youth and adult swim programs at Sylmar Pool and the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) Citywide Aquatics Division (CWA) for the 2023 Summer Season, and direct that appropriate recognition in the form of a certificate of appreciation be given to Paul and Mike Burgis of Burgis Holdings, LLC at the Sylmar Pool.

SUMMARY

Paul and Mike Burgis worked in the Aquatics division for RAP in the early 2000's as lifeguards at the Sylmar Swimming Pool as well as Open Water Lifeguard and Pool Managers later in their service to the City. They are now successful business professionals who believe in giving back to the community in which they grew up. The Burgis brothers are proud supporters of RAP's Aquatic Programs at Sylmar Swimming Pool.

The benefit of this Donation enabled the Sylmar Swimming Pool to provide free admission to 6,689 youth, 3,595 adults, and 263 seniors and people with disabilities during the 2023 Summer Season. In addition, 78 youth received free enrollments into youth programs (Surf Camp, Junior Lifeguards, Artistic Swimming, and Swimming) and 22 adults received free swim lessons.
