Full refunds are only issued when an activity is cancelled by the Recreation Center. A 15% cancellation fee per participant is assessed for all refunds prior to the start of class. Changes or transfers to classes are subject to a 15% administration fee per participant. After the first day of a session, the Recreation Center may issue a partial refund to patrons withdrawing from the activity, with approval of the Director in Charge.
