REGISTRATION INFORMATION

For Registration you will need:

- A copy of birth certificate or other proof of age
- Registration Fee due in full at time of registration
 - Visa and MasterCard accepted
 - Checks or Money Orders Payable to: CITY OF LOS ANGELES
 - A collection fee will be charged for each returned check
- Personal insurance needed, not provided by the CITY OF LOS ANGELES
- Volunteer Coaches needed. If interested, contact us at (323) 257-1863 to be interviewed, registered, and fingerprinted.

REFUND POLICY: NO REFUNDS unless a class or sports league is cancelled by the Recreation Center. In the event that a refund is granted under special circumstance a 15% administration fee will be assessed.

LEAGUE INFORMATION & FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

CARPOOL, SIBLINGS & REQUESTING A COACH: Carpool requests will not be accepted. Siblings will be placed on the same team unless otherwise requested. Players may not request a specific coach. Players are drafted and are not guaranteed to be placed on any specific team. **PRACTICES:** At this time it is not known which days or times your child(ren)'s team will practice. Weekday practices are typically scheduled between 4:00 PM and 9:00 PM and Saturday between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM. Practice length varies between 1 to 2 hours once or twice a week. There are no guarantees as to what time and day your child will practice each week. Refunds will not be issued if your child cannot make practices.

GAMES: The start of the season is tentatively scheduled for early January 2025. Teams will usually play one game during the week and one game on Saturday. Occasionally there may be 2 weekday games, no Saturday game or only a Saturday Game. Game times during the week are usually between 5:00 PM and 9:00 PM. Saturday game times are between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM. Game time will vary each week. At this time, game times and days have not been determined.

TRAVELING: Teams may be required to travel to other recreation centers or schools for games.

UNIFORMS: Uniforms will be available for pick up late December/early January.

MANDATORY PLAYING TIME: At the start of the first and second half, teams begin with their starting five players, who must play the first five consecutive minutes. At the 15-minute mark of each half, a mandatory substitution is called. Teams are required to insert all of the players that had previously been on the bench into the game. No free substitutions will be allowed during mandatory playing times (the first 10 minutes of each half). The remaining 10 minutes of each half would be free substitutions.

AWARDS: Each player who completes the season will receive an award at the end of league play. An Awards Ceremony will be scheduled at the end of league play. <u>Any award not collected on this day must be picked up within TWO WEEKS</u>. The recreation center will not be responsible for any awards not collected.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Your child's coach will be contacting you. If you do not receive a call by December 28, 2024, please call the recreation center. Please do not call the recreation center prior to that date regarding your child's practice. We would like to give your coach the opportunity to speak to you first.

Your coach will hold a parent meeting and give you all the information regarding your child's team and practice times. Please remember all coaches are volunteers and without them your child would not be able to participate.
