- Facility Updates
 - Looking to get renovations done in the kitchen, We've had several walkthroughs and just awaiting what the next steps will be.
 - Using donations from USC Keck we set up a computer lab for the Afterschool and Teen Club participants.
 - Will inquire about additional parking space/areas for patrons.
 - Batting cage received new turf lining
- Breakfast with Santa
 - Very successful, received donations from USC Keck, LAFD and had 10-12 families sponsored by USC.
- Winter Programs
 - Sports (Maria Esqueda)
 - Steadily growing in numbers
 - Anticipating 19 basketball teams
 - The goal is to have enough teams to play in-house

 - Hoping to have in house workshops for teens (writing resumes, interviewing, mental health, etc.)





New Business

 - Opening Day (baseball/softball) April 12, 2025
 - Looking to have an egg hunt, BBQ for the families, games and other activities.
 - Will seek assistance from Clinica Romero, USC Keck, Occupational Center and other neighboring community groups.
- Park Safety
 - Looking to have lights installed in the skatepark and batting cages.
 - Reached out to CD 14 for surveillance cameras to help with facility safety.
 - We have a growing concern with coyotes on the premises looking to add signs and communication to keep the patrons safe during the day.
- Summer 2025
 - Awaiting to hear back on additional support and funding
 - SNL hiring has begun
 - Summer camp registration will begin the week of April 5th and will run 8-9 weeks
 - Will reach out to local groups for additional funding if needed

- Would like to see the addition of a new parking lot and to repave the existing one.
- April 5th is a potential date for a community clean up
- Inquiries about the \$25 million donation which included an amphitheater
