TWO'S TRANSITION

Join us for Two's Transition!

This program is designed to help prepare your child to enter preschool.

Two's Transition is a teacher-led, structured playtime experience. In each class, the teacher will provide parent-guided experiences in circle time, songs, movement and story time.

<u>This is not a drop off program</u>. One adult must participate in the program with the child. There are songs to enjoy, concepts to learn and opportunities for group participation and interaction. Our goal is for every child to have fun while learning in a safe and nurturing environment. Please bring a healthy, nut free snack and drink for your child.

This program continues throughout the year with three sessions offered Fall, Winter and Spring. You have the option to keep your space by paying in advance of each new session. Spaces not paid for in advance will be offered to the waiting list.

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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Welcome to our Two's Transition Program. We hope to provide a special environment for you and your child to spend time together. This program will prepare your child to enter preschool as it is a structured playtime experience that is led by the teacher.

Our class is comprised of several parts: the beginning of the class is parent-directed, hands-on activities, the next portion is circle time, songs and movement, and lastly, children will have snack time and story time. Please bring your child a NUT FREE healthy snack and drink to each class.

Our goal for every child is to have fun while learning in a safe and nurturing environment. For the younger child, our goals include learning to increase your child's attention span and confidence in a group setting. For the older child, there are songs to enjoy, concepts to learn, an opportunity to participate in a group experience and follow directions from a teacher and feel successful.

CLASS POLICIES:

- 1. If you, your child or your child's caregiver are ill (green mucus, temperature, diarrhea, pink eye and other contagious illnesses), please do not attend class.
- 2. Children must be accompanied by their parent, grandparent, guardian or care giver.
- 3. Only non-crawling siblings are welcome. Remember, this is a special time for you and your child.
- 4. Clothing should be comfortable and appropriate for vigorous activities and messy play.
- 5. Please remember, our goal is to have fun. If a child is not interacting at a particular time, allow your child time to adjust to his or her new environment. This is a learning process.

IMPORTANT! Please consider this 1 hour and 15 minute class as precious bonding time with your child. Reduce distractions and choose to silence your phone before entering the class. If you MUST take a call or text, please go out into hallway WITH your child. Once you have completed your call/texting, we would love to have you both join us again in the class. Please respect the teacher and other classroom participants by adhering to this policy.

What to Bring:

- 1. Nut-Free snack and drink
- 2. Change of clothes for your child

Current registrants have priority enrollment for the following sessions. Please make payment on or before the due dates to secure your child's space for the next session. If you wish to discontinue your enrollment, please let the office know so we may contact our waitlist.
