VNRC,SVRC,DMG,RVRC: Turf/ Grass Soccer Field Rules

To preserve the quality of the turf and provide a healthy and clean environment, please observe the following rules:

- 1. Fields may be closed at any time for safety concerns.
- 2. Please utilize all trash receptacles to maintain a healthy and clean environment for all parties involved.
 - Goals must not be moved without the prior approval of a designated staff member.
 - a. All goals must be lifted when moved.
 - b. No dragging of equipment is allowed at any time.
- 4. Motor vehicles are not allowed on the field surface except for maintenance or emergencies.
- 5. Bicycles, skateboards, scooters and rollerblades are strictly prohibited.
- 6. Only water will be permitted on the field.
- 7. Gatorade, soda and all other beverages must be consumed outside the field. NO EXCEPTIONS!

a. Alcohol is strictly prohibited at all times!

- 8. No foods or snacks will be permitted inside the field area.
- 9. Spectators, players and coaches must refrain from placing any type of seating or shade structures on the turf field. Please use the cemented border for any chairs, benches, canopies, umbrellas, and ice chests.
- 10. Vending and/or selling of any items is strictly prohibited in the field area.
- 11. No glass containers.

- 12. No sunflower seeds or gum.
- 13. No usage of noise makers, fireworks or open flame.
- 14. No metals cleats or spikes will be allowed on the field.

a. Only flat rubber sole, turf sole and formed rubber cleats are allowed.

- 15. Stakes, spikes or pointed objects are prohibited from being used on the field at all times.
- 16. No animals will be allowed in the playing area. (Except to assist persons of disability).

Any participant or spectator who violates any policy, procedure, obstructs or prevents the program from operating, or engages in any verbal and/or physical abuse of the field will be asked to leave the facility immediately.
