#### CITYWIDE YOUTH SPORTS SPORTSMANSHIP STATEMENT

Good sportsmanship among spectators, parents, coaches, players, and officials is expected. We require that ALL spectators practice supportive and encouraging behavior at all times.

Inappropriate conduct and/or negative gestures are not allowed during any part of the game. Examples of such behavior include the following:

- Taunting the opposing team and their supporters.
- Derogatory comments to the officials/referees.
- Distracting players with stomping, yelling, and/or banging devices. Usage of loud sounds such as horns/whistles/bells are prohibited.

Failure to comply with the above rules may officially end the game and result in a forfeit loss for the offending team.



# 2024 CITYWIDE YOUTH SOCCER TOURNAMENT



### TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 1. All Citywide Youth Soccer rules shall apply.
- 2. All participants must sign in prior to playing in the game.
- 3. RULES PROTEST PROCEDURES: Protests will <u>only</u> be accepted concerning a misinterpretation of the rules. Coaches must notify officials prior to the start of the next play if there is a protest. The game will be stopped at that point and the committee will be called to make the final decision. The committee's decision shall be final. Protest time is part of game time. Protests will not be heard on official's judgment calls.
- 4. Games will start on time. There is no grace period. It is up to each team to allow proper travel time to get to each game venue on time. SOCCER: A team can start the game with 8 players but the 9th player must arrive before the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> half.
- 5. Teams should arrive at least 30 minutes prior to game time in order to allow ample time to sign in.
- 6. All games will be played out until there is a winner.
- 7. Any player, coach, or spectator that is ejected from the game, must leave the immediate vicinity of the playing field. The Citywide Sports Board reserves the right to determine a possible suspension of the person ejected based on the severity of the act/s leading to ejection.
